Parks, playgrounds and recreation areas in Providence are now tobacco free!



Effective March 11, 2015, Providence Ordinance 18-22 prohibits the sale or use of all tobacco and nicotine products including cigarettes, cigars, hookah, chewing tobacco, and electronic cigarettes in all city parks.

If you see neighbors using tobacco products in Providence Parks, please ask them to put out their cigarette or other product, or to take their tobacco use outside of the park.

Individuals violating Providence Ordinance 18-22 may receive a citation and fine of \$50 per violation.

Tobacco Free Parks will:

- Provide a healthier, tobacco-free environment at all of our parks to benefit children and adults alike
- Help our parks to be centers of wellness
- Reduce litter
