

# Kick Butts Day - 5<sup>th</sup> Annual Zombie Walk

## ZOMBIE WALK EVENT DETAILS

**When:** Wednesday, March 21, 2018

**What:** The Zombie Walk will engage high school age teens, programs and groups from across the state to participate in a free Kick Butts Day activity to build public awareness about the dangers of tobacco use. The event will kick-off at the Beneficent Congressional Church - Round Top Center space followed by a walk to the Statehouse where teens will deliver a message to decision makers and the public during a rally style press conference in the Statehouse Bell Area.

**Who:** High School Age Teen Groups

Teen groups and program adult leaders are responsible for collecting parent/guardian consent and permission forms, photo release forms and coordinating transportation to and from the event (as per school, group, or organization's policy). The adult-to-teen ratio should be one adult zombie for every 10-15 high school age zombies (between 1-to-10 and 1-to-15).

Teen groups may arrive as early as 2:30PM. Entrance to the Round Top Center is located on Chestnut Street. The event sign-in tables will be open between 2:30PM- 4:30PM. Upon sign-in, participants will receive a Zombie T-shirt, healthy snacks and sponsor giveaways (while supplies last). During this time teens will be zombified in face make-up followed by a brief presentation and overview of the walking route (approx. 1 mile) from the kick-off location to the Statehouse. The walk will begin at 5 PM. The exact start time may be subject to change. Metered street parking downtown.
