MEETING DEBRIEF

Draft of Final Policy Priorities:

- **Tobacco Retail Licensing & Point of Sale** Full range of issues that address tobacco licensing, and restrictions on tobacco products, promotion, and place.
 - State Level Goal:
 - Monitor for statewide preemption and be ready to mobilize, if needed
 - o Local Level Goal: Adoption of model policy
 - TFRI Specific Actions:
 - Educate and prepare youth to talk about TRL/POS
 - Speak at town/city council meetings to educate
 - Creation of factsheet / one pagers / campaign materials
- Tobacco 21 Prohibit tobacco products to be sold to anyone under 21
 - State Level Goal:
 - Assist other organizations in their work and send information to network
 - o Local Level Goal: Adoption of model policy (with TRL in place)
 - TFRI Specific Actions:
 - Educate and prepare youth to talk about T21
 - Speak at town/city council meetings to educate
 - Creation of factsheet / one pagers / campaign materials
- **Increase TCP Funding** return funding to historical high of \$3.1 million
 - o State Level:
 - Assist other organizations in their work and send information to network
 - Work with other orgs to craft an agreed upon policy statement around tax increase with focus on equity (proactive)

Draft of Policy Workgroup Structure Recommendations:

- June 2018 the group will begin the prioritization process via email followed by meetings in July/Aug to finalize recommendations prior to Annual Network Meeting
- The group will be reconvened via email for consultation on emerging issues
- For the next cycle of prioritization this group will have cessation represented

Other Policy Related Goals:

- Host training for prevention providers, community advocates, etc.
- Advocate and give support to BHDDH/Regional Coalitions for Rhode Island Student Survey to keep community level data around tobacco use

Next Steps:

- Announce recommendations at Annual Network Meeting
- Reconvene after fall network meeting to decide on work plan related to policy priorities
