 - Shannon recommended that the 22 behavior health centers all be included (come already have been added to the list) as they all work with tobacco related issues at some level.
 - The group discussed thinking bigger picture and being proactive
 - There is a need for a clear give/get relationship for new and preexisting network partners
 - Dan mentioned that there is a "give/get" sheet that is sent to partners in the onboarding process; however, he thinks it may need to be added to and revised to be more current.
 - The group discussed the need for establishing the "so what" element about why organizations should interact with TFRI.
 - "What. So What? Now What?"
 - Emphasis on continuing to energize new partners so they feel like they are a part of a comprehensive movement.
 - Request create a highlight reel on the website to highlight the work of partners.

Planning for Annual Network Meeting

- Dan began the conversation by describing what has already been planned for the annual network meeting
 - 10 12:30 at the Barrington Public Library
 - The first hour will be in the auditorium with a brief intro presentation from TFRI on accomplishments from the last year

 - Policy Workgroup
 - Will work on creating an action plan for what to accomplish for each policy priority
 - Cessation Workgroup
 - Population specific cessation resource and how to get out to the community
 - Strategic Development Workgroup
 - How to engage network better
 - Brainstorm give/gets and what partners are willing to do for the network

- The groups would then come back together and report out an overview of what they
 just worked on and what they plan to continue working on at their next workgroup
 meeting.
